Expands with New Edison Warehouse

ALPI USA has recently acquired a new warehouse facility located at **117 Sunfield Ave, Edison, 08837**, further strengthening our operational presence in the Northeast.

Strategically positioned within **Raritan Center**, one of New Jersey's most prominent business hubs, the facility is just **20 miles from the NJ/NY port complex and Newark International Airport**, offering excellent access to major transportation corridors.

The warehouse is equipped with **18 loading docks** and one ramp, enabling efficient inbound and outbound cargo handling. Security is supported by **24-hour video surveillance** with **39 cameras**, ensuring continuous monitoring and cargo protection. The facility also features racking capacity for approximately **4,000 pallet positions**, providing scalable storage solutions to meet growing customer demand.

ALPI USA has applied for **Bonded CFS (Container**

Freight Station) status at this location and is currently awaiting approval from **U.S. Customs and Border Protection**. Once approved, the facility will further enhance our bonded and customs-controlled service capabilities.

This expansion reflects ALPI USA's continued investment in infrastructure, compliance, and service excellence, positioning us for sustained growth and improved customer support throughout the region.

New Headquarters for new horizons

Following significant growth in 2025 and workforce expansion over the past year, the Rome branch has inaugurated its **new headquarters in Pomezia**, chosen for its strategic location.

The new facility—featuring **2,000 sqm of racked warehouse space** and **250 sqm of office space**—has been operational since March. It is located within the Pomezia industrial area, a strategic hub between Rome and the coast (ports). This area is one of the main production and logistics districts currently experiencing rapid expansion, driven especially by the logistics sector and the redevelopment of abandoned sites (Focus Area South). Beyond being a strategic regional choice, this location stream-

lines international shipments and goods distribution. These factors make Pomezia one of the most important and dynamic industrial districts in Lazio, playing a vital role in both the regional and national economies.

The new team, established in 2025 and already achieving **30% growth**, plans to continue expanding throughout 2026 to support the projects currently in development. The new warehouse, powered by advanced technologies such as a **cloud-based WMS** (Warehouse Management System), will enable the implementation of modern logistics characterized by increased efficiency, greater picking accuracy, and reduced human error. This transformation allows for higher storage density and optimized operational flows.

A new space, a new energy: we wish the Rome team every success in this new chapter!

AEDs installed in all italian branches

For this reason, the installation was paired with a significant investment in skills: our Human Resources department in Prato coordinated and organized specialized training sessions nationwide. Through these courses, several colleagues earned their **BLSD (Basic Life Support and Defibrillation)** certification, mastering the first-aid maneuvers necessary to act promptly and confidently. We haven’t just purchased equipment; we have built a network of people capable of looking out for one another.

Why This Choice?

In a dynamic workplace, safety cannot be seen merely as a regulatory requirement. Every year, the speed of intervention during cardiac arrest is the ultimate deciding factor for survival. Making our premises “cardio-protected” means:

- **Prevention:** Creating a safe environment for everyone who walks through our doors
- **Awareness:** Turning individual responsibility into a shared corporate culture
- **Human Value:** Putting the well-being of our professional “family” at the center of every location—“With Care” in Every Office

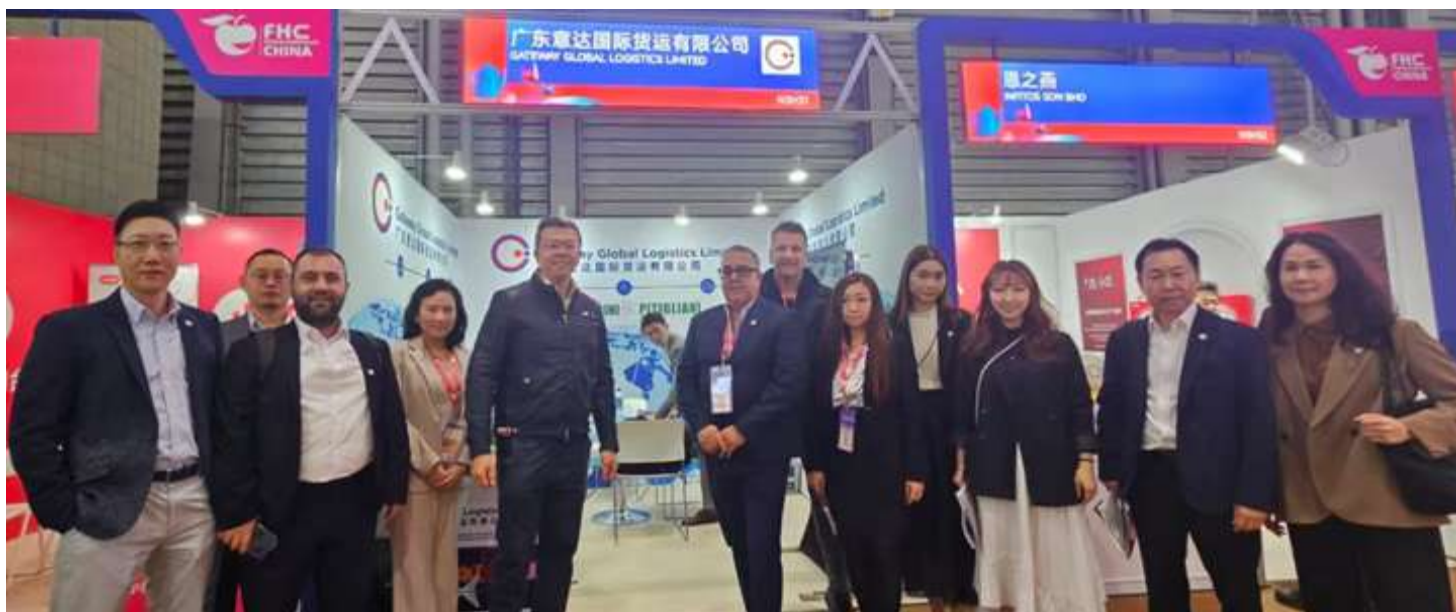
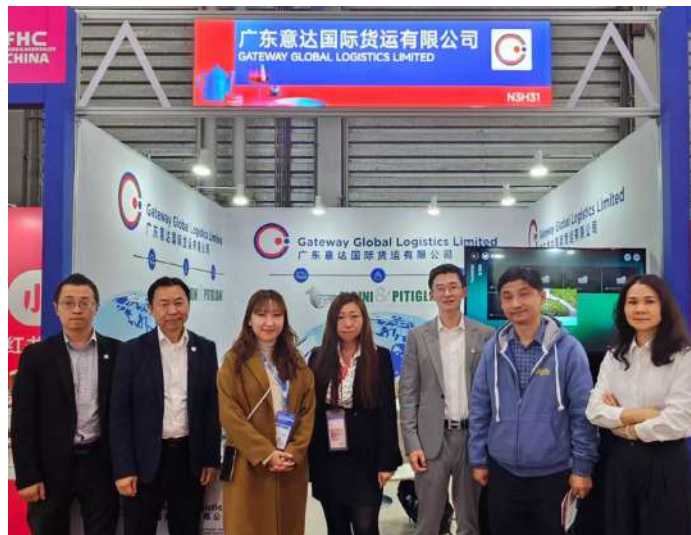

ALPI AIR&SEA

ALPI Air & Sea was established in Denmark in 2001 as a subsidiary of **ALPI Denmark**.

Over the past 25 years, many talented people have contributed to building ALPI Air & Sea—from 1 employee in 2001 to 80 employees in 2026. Both new and long-standing employees have played a role in shaping the company's development.

ALPI Air & Sea started in Herning in 2001, opened a branch in Odense in 2008, and another in Kolding in 2018. Together with ALPI Denmark, an entirely new logistics center was put into operation in 2017.

ALPI China, a subsidiary of ALPI Air & Sea, opened in 2019/2020. Today, ALPI China employs 25 people and achieved a record result in 2025.

ALPI Air & Sea Sweden was established in 2023. The start was challenging, but the team of 8 employees has now established a strong operational foundation and delivered a solid result in 2025.

In 2025, a branch in Aarhus opened as part of the effort to retain our skilled employees. In 2026, ALPI Air & Sea looks forward to putting a new 14,000 sqm terminal into operation in Kolding.

Although we have launched many new initiatives over the years and operated with a broad focus, we have nevertheless succeeded in retaining many skilled and committed employees across the organization.

“We are among the freight forwarding companies in the industry with the lowest employee turnover – one of our greatest and most important successes,”

says Morten Høgsberg Nielsen, Managing Director, ALPI Air & Sea. In 2024, ALPI Air & Sea achieved a turnover of EUR 58 million.

More employees, more business areas, more locations—a clear sign of the growth ALPI Air & Sea has experienced over the past 25 years. They will celebrate their **25th anniversary in Denmark in September 2026**, together with the inauguration of the new Kolding location.
